positive: Yes, Peter **has got** a box.

question: **Have I got** a T-shirt?

negative: No, I **haven't got** a T-shirt.

positive: Yes, I **have got** a T-shirt.

You have got a key.

question: **Have you got** a key?

negative: No, you **haven't got** a key.

positive: Yes, you **have got** a key.

She has got a cigarette.

question: **Has she got** a cigarette?

negative: No, she **hasn't got** a cigarette.

positive: Yes, she **has got** a cigarette.

He has got a uniform.

question: **Has he got** a uniform?

negative: No, he **hasn't got** a uniform.

positive: Yes, he **has got** a uniform.

The cat has got a bone.

question: **Has it got** a bone?

negative: No, it **hasn't got** a bone.

positive: Yes, it **has got** a bone.

We have got a book.

question: **Have we got** a book?

negative: No, we **haven't got** a book.

They have got a table.

question: **Have they got** a table?

negative: No, they **haven't got** a table.

You have got a lamp.

question: **Have you got** a lamp?

negative: No, you **haven't got** a lamp.
